Venue location and travel: The conference venue is [Universidad de Andres Bello](http://www.universidaddeandresbello.cl), located at Quillota 980, Viña del Mar, Región de Valparaíso, Chile. Location details are here: http://isoecol.com/2018/IsoEcol2018_Location.html

Talks will be in the Main (Red) Auditorium located on Floor -1. The Sunday reception (19:00 – 21:00), registration (Monday morning) and poster sessions will all be held in the Hall area of Floor/Piso -1. To get to Floor -1, once you have entered the main gate of the campus, walk to the left, where you will see the red steps descending to Floor -1. Take these, and we will see you downstairs! Registration: The 4ID.cl registration desk is open from 08.00 on Monday 30 July. To speed things up, you should present the barcode (*Ticket de acreditacion*) you were emailed from congress@4ID.cl. Once registered you will be provided with your conference badge and a delegate bad with a printed abstract book as well as some conference goodies.

It is important that you wear your badge throughout the conference as it allows other delegates to see who you are and where you are from. It also aids University security staff to identify delegates.



A conference helpdesk will be open Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday from 08:00 to 21:00, located in the hallway of Floor -1.

WiFi Internet Access: The conference WiFi network is **Congreso-isotopos** and the password is **COngr3so-2k18** NB: As the networks are shared please use responsibly (i.e. if your home institution network team were watching you).

Presentations: Information on presentations is given on the website at http://isoecol.com/2018/IsoEcol2018_Schedule.html and in the Abstract Book. Briefly, normal oral presentation slots are 15 minutes, to include changing speakers, the talk and associated questions. Chairs will be robust in their handling of those who attempt to go over the allotted time. Talk format is .PPTX or .PDF and must be uploaded the day prior to your presentation. Poster size is A0 portrait.

Food: During each day with talks (Mon, Tues, Thurs, Fri), there are morning and afternoon coffee breaks with ground coffee, tea, water and juice, and some light snacks. We will also supply lunch for delegates on these days (salad, sandwiches, soup, fruit, drinks). NB. Lunch breaks are only 1 hour, so please do not wonder off!
